Short walk nature discovery - Naishes Lane SANGS

Walk 2 - via Ewshot Lane

This is a circular route of 1.6 miles on the map below. Start at the car park at GU52 8DT and take the path at the end of the car park around the allotments. Stay on this path all the way to the Balancing Pond by heading down and keeping left and avoiding going into the housing. At the T junction after the housing, turn left. Then follow the path down to the balancing Pond. Take care entering Ewshot Lane at the Balancing Pond, turning left then with some walking along what can be a busy, narrow lane (highlighted blue), before you turn left onto a bridleway. The bridleway is a nice slightly up and down hill walk and passes Riddings Copse with roe deer (you need to be very quiet to see them) and 'pillboxes' from WWII. There has been a lot of pollarding of trees there and it has created an open environment worthy of exploration.

Follow the bridlepath and as it meets the road you can see the car park through the trees on the left.
